#### Beaumaris Lake

Beaumaris Lake is often referred to as the "Jewel of North Edmonton." It is the home for wild life, the site of recreation and socializing, and an important aspect of North Edmonton. It is also Edmonton's largest and oldest stormwater lake, and as such, it is starting to show its age. I have been advocating for, and working with, different City departments to develop a rehabilitation strategy to address the issues with Beaumaris Lake.

#### Background:

The City has been doing ongoing maintenance at Beaumaris Lake, but since the lake is nearing the end of its service life, this is no longer enough. In response to the on-going conditional issues, the City of Edmonton has initiated a task force divided into two working groups; one group to focus on short-term and immediate concerns, the other to focus on the medium and long term needs of Beaumaris. Update:

The full rehabilitation work is planned to start in 2019. This is because the budget cycles for these types of projects are set for three years. This budget schedule ends in 2018 (2015-2018), and the next one starts 2019. All of the resources (both funding and personnel) have been allocated to other projects for this budget cycle. As a result, the full rehabilitation cannot start. However, supplementary budgets are approved on an annual basis that can be used to maintain land until then.

Right now, the priority for Beaumaris Lake is safety, which can be addressed with those supplementary budgets. There are issues that aren't visible (such as inlet piping) that need to be considered. We realize that Beaumaris Lake is a valuable aspect of North Edmonton, and we want to keep it that way. If we do not address the issues Dave Loken with Beaumaris correctly, other issues may come up, or the repairs may not last long-term. Even replacing the park pieces around the lake will cost several million dollars, so we want to make sure the project is handled correctly. I am expecting a budget estimate soon.

## **Poison Prevention**

The Poison & Drug Information Service (PADIS) offers a free, confidential poison line for Albertans, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The service offers expert advice about poisons and toxins, medications, chemicals, recreational drugs and plants. When calling the poison centre, callers speak with a specially-trained nurse or pharmacist who gives information and offers advice on how to best manage poisonings and exposures.

Medication and herbal advice is also available through PADIS offering up-to-date information for the safe use of over-the-counter products, prescriptions, medications and herbals. This includes potential interactions between medications and/or herbals and safe medication options for pregnant and breast-feeding women.

PADIS plays a key role in helping Albertans safely manage poison exposures and can offer advice on the most appropriate level of health care service should it be needed.

PADIS also operates a Drug Information Line for Health Care Professionals. This free service for health professionals provides drug information for clinical situations, with the support of an on-call Medical Toxicologist.

If your child is in Grade 5, one set of these papers will be immunization consent forms, including consent for your child to receive the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine. The HPV vaccine - one of Alberta's routine childhood immunizations- is recommended for all boys and girls in Grade 5, so as to safely and effectively protect them against developing human papillomavirus infection in the future.

Human papillomavirus is very common, and will affect more than seven out of 10 people in their lifetime. As the cause of almost 100 per cent of cervical cancer cases, 90 per cent of anal cancer cases, 50 per cent of penile cancer cases, and 35 per cent of oral cavity cancer cases, the consequences of HPV can be very serious.

We understand that decisions about immunizing your children can be complex. This is why Alberta Health Services has developed the HPV Decision Aid Tool: to help you, as a parent, understand how the HPV Vaccine can support your child's future wellness, and decide whether you feel it is right for your child, today.

# Does an offer seem too good to be true? Could be a scam

The Better Business Bureau (BBB) has launched a handy Scam Tracker that makes it easy for Canadian residents to stay informed about scams that may be occurring in their area. The tracker allows you to click on your province via an interactive map and review a list of common scams.

The free interactive online tool – found at bbb.org/scamtracker – offers a heat map showing where scams are being reported. Users can search using a variety of filters to see what scams are happening in their area, or track a particular type of scam, or even see how much money has been lost. Users can also report scams that they hear about, whether or not they have fallen victim.

In 2012, two local BBBs – one in Edmonton, Alberta, and one in Las Vegas, Nevada – were credited with helping bring down Jesse Willms, the notorious fraudster who bilked more than four million people.
