AN ODE TO CARLISLE PIONEERS

Once upon a time, in 1973, a young family by the name of Jack & Denise Chapman moved into the new subdivision known as "Castledowns", just a couple blocks north and west of 137 Avenue and 113A Street. The neighbourhood streets weren't even paved yet, in fact, 113A Street did not exist north of 137 Avenue at the time.

They had two young children with them their son, Dean, who had to be bussed out to kindergarten, and their daughter, Sheri Anne, who was almost 3. Both Jack and Denise worked full-time jobs, but they saw the need in their new community for services - and especially a school! - and they acted on it.

Having worked at the Edmonton Catholic School Board several years before, Denise knew who to call (and was a five-foot tall fire cracker that wouldn't take no for an answer!), so she found out what was needed to get a school in the neighbourhood. With several like-minded neighbours, she set out to gather the 30 signatures necessary for the Board to consider getting an elementary school established.

Within a week of door knocking on evenings and weekends, they had 120 signatures! St. Timothy's, as of September 1975, was a go! It was a very simple set of porta-



bles, but it was a school, and it had a field to play in, and hills to slide down in the winter, and wonderful teachers, and it was in walking distance!

Jack would go on serving as the Carlisle Community League President (and Vice-President, and on the grants committe) for many years, Denise serving more of a background role (but no less important) with bake sales, winter carnivals, canvassing for memberships, and every other role she could fill. Jack coached boys baseball for years, and Denise coached girls softball as well. They were instrumental in getting the permanent school built, along with the playground (both the original and the one you see today), rinks, and community hall. Their kids went on to be volunteers with other community roles.

Jack passed away in May 2015, Dean passed away in March 2017, and Denise recently passed away in January 2018. My parents inspired many in the community to start volunteering, and to continue to do so. They both held down full-time jobs and took my brother and I to every sport or extra-curricular activity we enrolled in. I can only hope that this ode to my parents will inspire just one person to participate just a little more in their community, even in the simplest of manner.
