
a) Be enrolled in a post-secondary institu-

I'm not going to lie, I first volunteered for my Community League because I wanted to find a babysitter. My husband had just released from the military, our friends were being posted away and we were losing our military community and supports. Despite having lived in Caernarvon for 7 years, I didn't actually know anyone in my neighbourhood. At an AGM/soccer registration 12 years ago, I cast a critical eye to the board and figured someone there had a teenager at home with a babysitting certificate, so I volunteered for a position I didn't know anything about. As it turned out, I got a lot more than I bargained for.

Volunteering for my community league did find me a babysitter. It also found me friends, contacts, and networks. I met people who taught me skills, and I discovered what was going on in my neighbourhood. More than that, it showed me what I was capable of,

what I was good at, and things I wanted to do in my life (and some things I didn't). I learned effective communication skills, time management, grant writing, event organization, and how citizens influence City decision-making. It is something I proudly put on my resume because it gives me tangible skills, and means something important to me. I don't need a babysitter anymore but I'm still here because I love contributing to a non-profit organization that makes a difference in my community. Because I did, after all, find my new community.






