## Baturyn Park Rehabilitation NEW PLAYGROUND DEVELOPMENT

The City of Edmonton has chosen the Baturyn community to use infrastructure funding to invest in our community's City-owned playground infrastructure. This is outside of the City's regular Neighbourhood Park Development Program (NPDP), which commonly focuses on playground renewal.


### WHAT DOES THIS MEAN TO YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD?

The playground at 10505 172 Avenue NW will be replaced with a NEW PLAYGROUND in 2021! The scope of this renewal will include new playground equipment and safety surfacing at the site at no cost to the Community. Construction on both playground pods is planned for spring/summer 2021 with a target completion of fall 2021.


The Baturyn Playground Committee will continue meeting on a regular basis to develop equipment (such as seating and shade) in the area surrounding the playground equipment. ### Bingo volunteer

Cumberland-Oxford Community League is looking for Volunteer to take Bingo Director's position. This is a very important position as bingos provides a significant source of revenue for the league. That revenue is used to fund various projects and programs. Some of which include

- Soccer
- Baseball/softball
- Ice rinks
- Playground construction/expansion
- Community garden
- Haunted forest
- Park parties/events (ie. Yoga, summer kickoff party)

Without the bingo fundraisers, we would have

to significantly reduce the amount of programming and projects as well as significantly raise the fees for programs like soccer or softball.

This position is entitled to COCL Bucks which can be used towards COCL sports registration or other community events.

Bingo Director will work with Bingo Assistants to organize volunteers, assign positions, count money and ensure that bingo events run as smoothly as possible. COCL typically runs 12 bingos a year. At each bingo, either the director or an assistant will need to be at the hall for 4:30 pm, staying until the paperwork is balanced at the end of the event, usually a little after midnight. 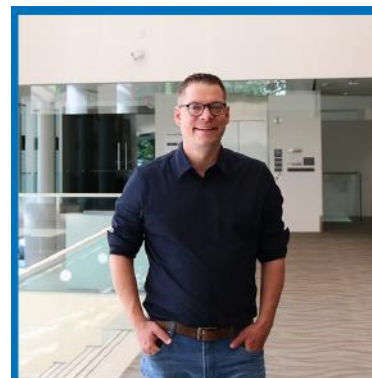
