Central Edmonton bridges renewal: what to expect in 2025

Wellington Bridge: Replacement of the bridge will begin in late 2025, aligning with anticipated completion of the Valley Line West LRT road work on Stony Plain Road. The bridge is expected to reopen by late 2026, with landscaping finished in 2027.

Dawson Bridge: Repairs starting in summer 2025 will extend the bridge's service life. This work will require occasional night and weekend closures. Work is expected to be completed by the end of 2025.

Low Level Bridge (Southbound): Maintenance will require a full closure of the southbound struc-

ture starting in late summer/fall 2025. Southbound traffic will be rerouted to the northbound Low Level Bridge, while northbound traffic will shift to 98 Avenue (James MacDonald Bridge). Work is expected to be completed by the end of 2025.

High Level Bridge: Design for renewal is in progress, with construction timelines to be determined.

Traffic management plans will be further communicated as specific project construction timelines are confirmed. For more information:
